Dear Parents and Guardians,

As part of our wellbeing programme during Remote Teaching and Learning we are working with CHI Crumlin (Crumlin Children's Hospital) to develop content for their in-patient TV channel. The Student Council came up with this idea and are hopeful that as a community we can make it happen during this period of lockdown.

The hospital would like students in **Our Lady's Grove** to create video content that will amuse, distract and occupy the young people who are in hospital. These videos and clips will be screened on the hospital in-patient TV channel.

During Wellbeing timetabled classes this week, we will explain what type of content we are hoping to create and how to submit the videos. We have a list of suggestions to help students get started and we will also screen some sample clips using people, Avatars, and animation so that everyone can see the options available to them. We will give some time to brainstorming, developing ideas and answering questions. During the following weeks we aim to create the videos which will be between 3 and 5 minutes long.

We hope to have completed the initial stage of gathering all the content by February 1<sup>st</sup>. We will then send you a link checking that you give your permission for your daughter's video to be shared with the hospital. If you do not give permission, we will delete your daughter's video. Please find attached a letter from the hospital outlining how the content we generate will be used, shared and deleted.

We really hope that everyone enjoys taking part in this initiative. These weeks at home are very hard on our young people but the message from our Student Council is that one of the best ways we can help ourselves feel better is to do something for someone else. Hopefully, the creative and fun element of this project will be something that helps our young people and those in Crumlin.
